AWARD

The Government of Orissa in the Labour & Employment Department in exercise of powers conferred upon them by sub-section (5) of section 12 read with clause (d) of sub-section (1) of section 10 of the Industrial Disputes Act, 1947 (14 of 1947) have referred the following dispute for adjudication vide their Order No. 11456/LE., dated the 16th October 1998.

“ Whether the termination of services of Shri Purna Chandra Samartha w.e.f 21.6.1969 by the Management of Executive Engineer, Bhubaneswar City Distribution Division, Bhubaneswar is legal and/or justified ? If not, what relief the workman is entitled to ?”

2. The concerned workman is absent on repeated calls. No steps taken on his behalf. The case is posted today for hearing. No prayer is also made by either party to adjourn the case to some other date for hearing. On perusal of the case record, it is seen that, the workman has been remained absent since the 12th May 2004. Since the concerned workman is absent today no award is possible. Hence a no dispute Award is passed accordingly.
