AWARD

1. This case arises out of the reference made by the Government of Orissa, Labour & Employment Department U/s. 10 and 12 of the Industrial Disputes Act, 1947 vide Memo No. 61(5), dated the 2nd January, 2004 for adjudication scheduled bellow :—

“ Whether the action of the Management of N.A.C., Angul in terminating the services of Shri Hajari Gochhayat and 12 others (as per Annexure'D') by way of disengagement with effect from 27th March, 2002 issued vide Order No. 1377, dated the 27th March, 2002 of the Executive Officer Angul N.A.C., Angul is legal and/or justified ? If not what relief the workmen are entitled to ?”

2. After filing of statement of claim and written statement by the workmen and Management respectively, they did not attend in the court and also took no steps inspite of repeated notices from the Court. As it appears, the workmen are not interested to proceed with the present case. Hence I do hereby pass a “No Dispute Award” so far as the present reference is concerned.
