The State Level Sanctioning Committee (SLSC) will ensure the following :—

(i) To examine and approve project reports submitted by the Urban Local Bodies/implementing agency including Parastatal agencies taking into account of the appraisal reports. To assign higher priority to projects relating to water supply including sanitation, sewerage, solid waste management, road net work & drainage.

(ii) To monitor periodically, the progress of sanctioned projects/schemes including funds mobilization from financial institutions.

(iii) To review the implementation of the scheme keeping in view its broad objectives and ensure that the programmes taken up are in accordance with the guidelines laid down.

(iv) To review the progress the urban reform being undertaken by ULBs/Parastatal/ implementing agencies.

The SLSC shall meet as often as required but shall meet at least thrice in a year without fail and review the progress of on-going projects and sanction new projects.
