S.R.O. No.328/2008—The following draft of certain rules further to amend the Orissa Factories Rules, 1950, which the State Government propose to make in exercise of the powers conferred by section 112 of the Factories Act, 1948 (63 of 1948) is hereby published as required by section 115 of the said Act for information of all persons likely to be affected thereby and notice is hereby given that the said draft will be taken into consideration by the State Government on or after the expiry of a period of forty-five days from the date of publication of this notification in the Official Gazette.

Any objection or suggestion which may be received from any person in respect of the said draft before the expiry of the period so specified will be considered by the State Government.

DRAFT

1. (1) These rules may be called the Orissa Factories (Amendment) Rules, 2008.

(2) They shall come into force on the date of their publication in the *Orissa Gazette*.

2. In the Orissa Factories Rules, 1950 (hereinafter referred to as the said rules), in rule 7, for sub-rule-4, the following sub-rule shall be substituted, namely :—

“(4) the occupier shall have the option to apply for renewal of licence by the Chief Inspector in “Form 4A” for a term of five consecutive calendar years with five times of usual licence fee in vogue”.

3. In the said rules after “Form 4”, the following Form shall be inserted, namely :—

“FORM-4A”**(Prescribed under sub-rule (4) of Rule 7)
(RENEWAL OF LICENCE TO WORK A FACTORY)**
