AWARD

Originally the Government in the Labour & Employment Department had referred the following dispute for adjudication by the Presiding Officer, Labour Court, Bhubaneswar vide its Order No. 12173-li/1-(B)-300/1994/LE., dated the 7th September 1995 but subsequently it transferred the dispute to be adjudicated by the Industrial Tribunal, Bhubaneswar vide its Order No. 4138-li/21-32/2007/LE., dated the 4th April 2008.

“Whether the termination of employment of Shri Sankar Barik, Fitter by the employer of M/s. Orissa Insulation, Jagatpur, Cuttack with effect from 27th January 1992 is legal and/or justified ? If not, to what relief he is entitled ?”

2. This case was posted to 15th September 2008 for hearing. On that date both the parties remained absent and did not take any steps.

On perusal of record, it reveals that after filing of their respective claim statement and written statement, issues were settled on 12th June 2001 and thereafter on the petitions of the parties that a talk of compromise was going on, the case was adjourned from time to time till 15th December 2003. However, after 15th December 2003 the parties have neither appeared nor taken any steps in the proceeding.

From the conduct of the parties, as aforesaid, there is every reason to presume that either the dispute no more subsists between the parties or the same has been settled in the meantime and accordingly, a no dispute Award is passed in so far as the present reference is concerned.
