ORDER

The 3rd November 2008

No. 6639—ELE(ML) -43/2008-SEC.—Whereas, the Election Commission of India vide their Letter No. 56, dated the 2nd July 2008 have recognized Rastriya Janata Dal as a National Party and the “Symbol Hurricane Lamp” has been allotted as reserved Symbol;

And, whereas, it has been provided in Para. 8 (1) of the Election Symbols (Reservation and Allotment) Order, 1968 that a candidate set-up by a National Party at election in any Constituency in India shall choose, and shall be allotted the symbol reserved for that party and no other symbol;

And, whereas, the appendix to the Orissa Municipal Corporation (Division of City into Wards, Reservation of Seats and Conduct of Elections) Rules, 2003 specifics certain free Symbols for independent candidates to be adopted in Municipal Corporation Elections and the Symbol “Hurricane Lamp” is one of the free Symbol.

Now, therefore, in exercise of powers conferred under Article 243-ZA of the Constitution of India and Rule 24(8) of Orissa Municipal Corporation (Division of City into Wards, Reservation of Seats and Conduct of Elections) Rules, 2003, the State Election Commission has been pleased to delete “Hurricane Lamp” from the list of free symbols for independent candidates in the Municipal Corporation Election.
