## AWARD

Originally, the Government of Orissa in the Labour & Employment Department had referred the following dispute for adjudication by the Presiding Officer, Labour Court, Bhubaneswar vide its Order No. 1899—li/1(B)-117/1992-L.E., dated the 6th February 1995 but subsequently it transferred the dispute to be adjudicated by the Presiding Officer, Industrial Tribunal, Bhubaneswar vide its Order No. 4138—li/21-32/2007-L.E., dated the 4th April 2008:—

“ Whether the action of the Management of O.S.R.T.C., Cuttack on non-regularising the services of Shri Ashok Kumar Mohanty, Station Master for the period from the 27th May 1984 to the 20th July 1984 is legal and/or justified ? If not, what relief he is entitled to ?”

2. This case was posted to the 10th November 2008 for hearing. After filing their respective claim statement and written statement, both the parties are not taking any interest for participating in the hearing.

The record discloses that the case has suffered several adjournments due to non-appearance of the parties. This being an year old case pending since the year 1995, it is felt expedient to dispose of the reference. Further in absence of any evidence on record, the reference cannot be answered in any manner.

Hence a “ No Dispute Award ” is passed accordingly.
