The Workman has not filed the Statement of Claim though several opportunities are given to him notwithstanding the mandate given to dispose of the case with six months. Notice has been issued to the workman by Reg. Post. It appears that the service of the notice is held to be sufficient as the postal cover is not received back.

Hence “No Dispute Award” is passed accordingly.
