AWARD

The Government of Orissa in exercise of powers conferred by sub-section (5) of Section 12, read with Clause (c) of sub-section (1) of Section 10 of the Industrial Disputes Act, 1947 have referred the matter in dispute to this Court vide Order No.166—li/1(B)-101/2002-LE., dated the 4th January 2003 of the Labour & Employment Department, Orissa, Bhubaneswar.

2. The terms of reference is as follows:

“Whether the action of the management of M/s Kalson Plant and Equipment Pvt. Ltd., Mancheswar Industrial Estate, Bhubaneswar in terminating the services of Shri Maguni Rout, Moulder and Kailash Rout, Moulder with effect from 26th May 2001 are legal or justified ? If not, what relief they are entitled to ?”

3. In this case, though the workmen filed their statement of claim but subsequently remained absent. The management neither filed written statement nor attend the court. Both the parties have also not adduced any evidence. In absence of evidence, an award cannot be passed. In the circumstance, a No Dispute Award is passed in so far as the present reference is concerned.
