AWARD

The Government of Orissa in the Labour & Employment Department in exercise of powers conferred upon them by sub-section (5) of Section 12, read with Clause (d) of sub-section (1) of Section 10 of the Industrial Disputes Act, 1947 (14 of 1947) have referred the following dispute for adjudication vide their Order No. 3923—li/1(B) 59/2007-LE., dated the 29th March 2008.

“Whether the action of the management of M/s. Jatni Service Station, At Ramachandrapur Bazar, P.O./P.S. Jatni, Dist. Khurda in terminating the services of Shri Susanta Kumar Mohanty, Pump Attendant w.e.f. the 12th April 2005 is legal and/or justified ? If not, what relief Shri Mohanty is entitled to ?”

2. In this case the second party workman has filed his claim statement . The Management despite notice did not file its written statement and was set *ex parte* vide Order dated the 28th May 2009. The second party workman was thereafter noticed for *ex parte* hearing, and inspite of notice he did not appear. From the conduct of the workman it can safely be presumed that he is no more interested to pursue the litigation. In absence of any evidence it is not possible to answer the reference in any manner. Hence, a no dispute Award is passed in so far as the present reference is concerned.
