### NOTIFICATION

The 1st December, 2009

**S.R.O.No. 493/2009**—The following draft of certain rules which the State Government propose to make in exercise of the powers conferred by Section 387 of the Orissa Municipal Act, 1950 (Orissa Act 23 of 1950) further to amend the Orissa Municipal Rules, 1953, is hereby published as required by Section 392 of the said Act, for the information of all persons / ULBs likely to be affected thereby and notice is hereby given that the said draft will be taken into consideration by the State Government on or after the expiry of a period of fifteen days from the date of publication of this notification in the *Orissa Gazette*.

Any objection or suggestion which may be received from any person / ULB in respect of the said draft before the date so specified above will be taken into consideration by the State Government.

### DRAFT

1. (1) These rules may be called the Orissa Municipal (Amendment) Rules, 2009.  
(2) They shall come into force on the date of their publication in the *Orissa Gazette*.
2. In the Orissa Municipal Rules, 1953,
  - (i) rule 93 shall be renumbered as Sub-rule (1) thereof and the figure, words and the brackets “Rs.25,000/- (Rupees twenty five thousand)” appearing therein shall be substituted by the figure, words and the brackets “Rs.1,00,000/- (Rupees one lakh)”; and
  - (ii) after Sub-rule (1) as so re numbered, the following Sub-rule shall be inserted, namely:—

“(2) If a Bill or the claim for payment so presented to the Chairperson is not signed or returned with reasons of non-approval within seven days of its presentation, then the E.O. shall do well to get the Bill countersigned by the District Magistrate”.
