### NOTIFICATION

The 31st December 2008

No. 13145-Emp-II-116/07/LE.— In exercise of the powers conferred by *proviso* to Article 309 of the Constitution of India, the Governor of Orissa makes the following rules further to amend the Orissa Employment Service, Class-II (Recruitment and Conditions of Service) Rules, 1990, namely:—

1. (1) These rules may be called the Orissa Employment Service Class-II (Recruitment and Conditions of Service) Amendment Rules, 2008.

(2) They shall come into force on the date of their publication in the *Orissa Gazette*.

2. In the Orissa Employment Service Class-II (Recruitment and Conditions of Service) Rules, 1990 (hereinafter referred to as the said rules), in Rule 4, for clause (a), the following clause shall be substituted, namely: —

“(a) On deputation including from Orissa Administrative Service”.

3. In the said rules, for Rule 5, the following rules shall be substituted, namely:—

“5. (1) The total number of vacancies shall be calculated in the month of January of the year and intimation regarding the number of vacancies against deputation and promotion shall be intimated to Government by the Director, Employment, Orissa separately.

(2) The Government on receipt of the vacancy position shall decide the number of vacancies in the service required to be filled up in particular year.”

4. In the said rules, in Rule 6, for sub-rule (1) and (2), the following sub-rules shall be substituted, namely:—

“(1) The number of vacancies to be filled up by way of deputation under clause-(a) of Rule 4 shall be of twenty five percent of the vacancy in any year.

(2) The number of vacancies to be filled up by way of promotion under clause-(b) of Rule, 4 shall be of seventy five percent of the vacancy in any year.

5. In the said Rules, Chapter-III, shall be deleted.

6. In the said Rules, Rule 25 and 26 shall respectively be deleted.
