AWARD

This matter arises out of a reference made by the Government of Orissa, Labour & Employment Department under Sections 10 & 12 of the Industrial Dispute Act, 1947, in their Memo No. 9657(4), dated the 3rd November 2006 for adjudication of the following questions :

“ Whether refusal of employment/service of Shri Rama Chandra Senapati, Guest House Attendant with effect from the 28th February 2002 under V.R. Scheme by the management of Bargarh Co-operative Sugar Mills Ltd., Tora, Bargarh is legal and/or justified ? If not, what relief Shri Rama Chandra Senapati is entitled to ? ”

2. On notices being sent, the workman did not appear nor filed statement of claim for the reasons best known to him. From this, it can safely be inferred that the workmen has no dispute with the management or they have settled their dispute outside the court in the meantime. Accordingly, an Award of no dispute is passed in so far as reference is concerned.
