No. 2929—I-TTI-45/2008-I—Consequent upon the interim order of Hon'ble Apex Court, dated the 16th May 2008 in I. A. No. 10 on Civil Appeal No. (S) 2871/2007, the Fee Structure Committee constituted vide this Department Notification No. 9425, dated 26th June 2007 was revived vide this Department Notification No. 9052, dated the 17th June 2008 to recommend the fee structure for new Technical/Professional Institutions for MCA and MBA Programmes newly introduced in existing Technical/Professional Institutions and on other relevant issues regarding fee structure for the Academic Session 2008-09. The tenure of the Fee Structure Committee so revived was extended to the 14th January 2009 vide this Department Notification No. 17889, dated the 26th December 2008 for completion of the works assigned to it.

The Fee Structure Committee so revived submitted its recommendation on fee structure in respect of new Technical/Professional Institutions and for newly approved Programmes in existing institutions through proceedings of the Fee Structure Committee meeting held on the 14th January 2009. The Orissa Private Engineering College Association (OPECA) put forth their grievances with respect to the recommendation of the Fee Structure Committee submitting that the Committee have recommended fee structure in a hurriedly manner and requested for reassessment of the fee structure.

After careful consideration of the grievances of OPECA, Government have been pleased to revive the aforesaid Fee Structure Committee with immediate effect for a period of two months to discuss the issues raised by OPECA and consider, if necessary, a reassessment of the suggested fee structure.
