AWARD

Originally, the Government of Orissa in the Labour & Employment Department had referred the following dispute for adjudication by the Presiding Officer, Labour Court, Bhubaneswar vide its Order No. 12439—li/1(BH)-35/2001-L.E., dated the 4th September 2001, but subsequently it transferred the dispute to be adjudicated by the Presiding Officer, Industrial Tribunal, Bhubaneswar vide its Order No. 4138—li/21-32/2007-L.E., dated the 4th April 2008 :—

“Whether the action of the Management of M/s. Cables India (P) Limited, Balasore in refusing employment to Shri Gokulananda Dash and others with effect from the 23rd July 1999 is legal and/or justified ? If not, what relief they are entitled to ?”

2. In this case, both the parties after filing their respective claim statement and written statement did not appear on the dates of hearing. The second party workmen have not tendered any evidence to substantiate their claim, so also the Management. Under such circumstance, it is not possible to answer the reference in any manner. Hence, a No Dispute Award is passed in so far as the present reference is concerned.
