AWARD

1. The Government of Orissa in the Labour & Employment Department have in exercise of power conferred upon them under sub-section (5) of Section 12, read with clause (c) of sub-section (1) of Section 10 of the Industrial Disputes Act, 1947 (for short, 'the Act') referred the following disputes for adjudication by this Court.

“Whether the action of the Management of Urban Co-operative Bank Limited Rourkela in terminating the service of Shri P. K. Mohapatra, Sr. Assistant with effect from the 17th July 2002 is legal and/or justified? If not, to what relief Shri Mohapatra is entitled?”

2. On notices being sent, the workman did not appear nor filed statement of claim for the reasons best known to him. From this, it can safely be inferred that the workman has no dispute with the management or they have settled their dispute outside the Court in the meantime, Accordingly, an Award of No-Dispute is passed in so far as reference is concerned.
