## AWARD

The Government of Orissa in the Labour & Employment Department have in exercise of power conferred upon them under Section 12 of sub-section (5), read with Clause (c) of sub-Section (1) of Section 10 of the Industrial Disputes Act, 1947, (for short “the Act”) referred the following disputes for adjudication by this Court :—

“Whether the termination of services of Shri Pahali Das, workman by the management of M/s Contractors India Pvt. Ltd., At/P.O. Bijigol, Dist. Angul, a contractor of M/s NTPC Ltd., TSTPP., Kaniha, Talcher, Dist. Angul with effect from the 20th October 2005 is legal and/or justified ? If not, what relief is the workman entitled to ?”

2. On notices being sent, the workman did not appear nor filed his statement of claim for the reasons best known to him. From this, it can safely be inferred that the workman has no dispute with the management or they have settled their dispute outside the Court in the meantime. Accordingly, an Award of ‘No Dispute’ is passed in so far as reference is concerned.
