AWARD

Originally, the Government of Orissa in the Labour & Employment Department had referred the following dispute for adjudication by the Presiding Officer, Labour Court, Bhubaneswar vide its Order No. 1792, dated the 9th February 1999 but subsequently it transferred the dispute to be adjudicated by the Presiding Officer, Industrial Tribunal, Bhubaneswar vide its Order No. 4138—li/21-32/2007-LE., dated the 4th April 2008.

“Whether the termination of services with effect from the 1st September 1997 of Shri Prafulla Chandra Beura, Sweeper by Orissa State Co-operative Bank Ltd., Bhubaneswar is legal and/or justified ? If not, to what relief Beura is entitled ?”

2. In this case, both the parties after filing their respective claim statement and written statement did not appear on the dates of hearing. The second party-workman has not tendered any evidence to substantiate their claim, so also the management. Under such circumstance, it is not possible to answer the reference in any manner. Hence, a no dispute award is passed in so far as the present reference is concerned.
