AWARD

The Government of Orissa in the Labour & Employment Department in exercise of powers conferred upon them by sub-section (5) of Section 12 read with clause (d) of sub-section (1) of Section 10 of the Industrial Disputes Act, 1947 (14 of 1947) have referred the following dispute for adjudication vide their Order No. 6708–li/1 (B)-48/2003, dated the 15th July 2003 :-

“Whether the termination of services of Shri Nanda Senapati, Head Clerk, with effect from 1st November 2002 by the management of M/s. Nilachal Lodge, Swargadwar, Puri is legal and/or justified ? If not, to what relief he is entitled ?”
