AWARD

The Government of Orissa in the Labour & Employment Department in exercise of powers conferred upon them by sub-section (5) of Section 12 read with clause (d) of sub-section (1) of Section 10 of the Industrial Disputes Act, 1947 (14 of 1947) have referred the following dispute for adjudication vide their Order No. 11691–li/1 (B)-42/2007-L.E., dated the 22nd October 2007 :—

“Whether the action of the management of Orissa Bridge and Construction Corporation Ltd., Nayapalli, Bhubaneswar in terminating the services of Shri Achyutananda Samal, Junior Accounts Asst. (Temporary) with effect from 16-3-2005 is legal and/or justified ? If not, what relief Shri Samal is entitled to ?”

2. Both parties are absent. No steps taken. In absence of parties and evidence on record, the reference can not be answered. Hence a no Award possible is passed accordingly.
