“Whether the dismissal of services of Shri Rabindra Singh and Bablu Kumar Singh with effect from 16-10-2001 and Shri Dhananjaya Santra and 19 others (as per list) with effect from 21-5-2002 by the management of M/s Passari Cellulose Ltd., Balgopalpur, Balasore is legal and/or justified ? If not, to what relief the workmen are entitled ?”
