AWARD

The Government of Orissa in the Labour & Employment Department in exercise of the powers conferred upon them by sub-section (5) of Section 12, read with Clause (d) of sub-section (1) of Section 10 of the Industrial Disputes Act, 1947 (14 of 1947) have referred the following dispute for adjudication vide their Order No. 9533–li/1 (B)-18-2006 LE., Dt. 2-11-2006.

“Whether the dismissal of Shri Ramakanta Sahoo, Cadre Secretary with effect from 18-2-2005 by the management of Balasore-Bhadrak Central Co-operative Bank Ltd., At/P.O. Balasore is legal and/or justified ? If not, what relief Shri Sahoo is entitled to ?”

2. The workman is absent. No steps taken. On perusal of the case record I find that he was absent in the Court since long and also not filed his claim statement which shows he is not interested to proceed with his case. I also found no reasonable ground to adjourn the case further more as sufficient opportunities has been given to him. Hence in absence of claim statement and evidence on record a no awarad possible is passed accordingly.
