AWARD

The Government of Orissa in the Labour & Employment Department in exercise of powers conferred upon them by sub-section (5) of Section 12, read with Clause (d) of sub-section (1) of Section 10 of the Industrial Disputes Act, 1947 (14 of 1947) have referred the following dispute for adjudication vide their Order No. 3629-li/1(B)-125/2009-L.E., dated the 15th April 2009.

"Whether the termination of services of Bhubaneswar in terminating the services of Shri Baikuntha Pradhan, Ex-Skilled Workman with effect from the 1st March 2002 by the Management of M/s. Kalinga Felt and Tar Industries (P) Ltd., is legal and/or justified ? If not, to what relief Shri Pradhan is entitled to ?"

2. Parties are absent. No steps taken. On perusal of the case record, it is seen that the workman neither present nor taken any step to file statement of claim in this case though sufficient opportunities given to him. In the circumstances, in absence of workman and statement of claim and also evidence on record, a no Award possible is passed accordingly.
