No. 8376—I.TT-I-06/2011-I—In pursuance of the provisions of the Orissa Professional Educational Institutions (Regulation of Admission and Fixation of Fee) Act, 2007 and consequent upon the Interim Order of the Hon'ble Supreme Court, dated the 1st June 2007 in the petitions for special leave to Appeal (Civil) No. (S) 10318/2007 and in three others, dated the 18th June 2007 in Civil Appeal No. (S) 2872 of 2007, Government was pleased to constitute the Fee Structure Committee (F.S.C.) and Policy Planning Body (P.P.B.) vide Notification No. 9425—I.TT-I-41/2007(Pt.), dated the 26th June 2007 and Notification No. 9527—I.TT-I-43/2007, dated the 28th June 2007 respectively. The Fee Structure Committee so constituted is now functioning under the Chairmanship of Hon'ble Mr. Justice K. P. Mohapatra to recommend fee structure for admission to the Private Professional Educational Institutions and Sponsored Institutions and matter incidental thereto. The Policy Planning Body so constituted is now functioning under the Chairmanship of Hon'ble Mr. Justice Arun Kumar Parichha to recommend policy for regulation of admission and matter incidental thereto. Hon'ble Supreme Court in their Order, dated the 5th May 2011 passed in I.A. No. 21/2011 in Civil Appeal No. 2871 of 2007 has directed that the Fee Structure Committee (F.S.C.) and Policy Planning Body which was constituted in terms of the Order passed by this Court for the session 2007-2008, will continue for the academic year 2011-2012 also.

Consequent upon the Order of the Hon'ble Apex Court, dated the 5th May 2011 passed in I.A. No. 21/2011 in Civil Appeal No. 2871 of 2007, Government have been pleased to allow for functioning of the Policy Planning Body and Fee Structure Committee for the academic session 2011-2012, i.e. with effect from the 1st June 2011 to 31st May 2012 or until further orders of the Government whichever is earlier.
