No. 8412—I.TTI-90/2011-I—All India Council for Technical Education (A.I.C.T.E.) have introduced a Scheme in the name and style of the Tuition Fee Waiver Scheme for economically backward meritorious students to promote technical education. The A.I.C.T.E. in its Approval Process Hand Book, 2011-2012 has prescribed that seats up to maximum of 5 per cent of sanctioned intake per course which are supernumerary in nature shall be available for these admissions under the above scheme.

Further, it has been prescribed that the above scheme shall be mandatory for all the institutions approved by the Council (A.I.C.T.E.).

After careful consideration of the above scheme, Government have been pleased to implement the scheme in the State from the academic session 2011-2012 subject to the following guidelines/conditions/stipulation and procedures :—

1. Scheme shall be applicable to all approved Technical Institutions offering Bachelor Programmes, Diploma and Post Diploma Programme of three/four years duration.
2. Seats up to maximum 5 per cent of sanctioned intake per course shall be available for these admissions. These seats shall be supernumerary in nature.
3. The Competent Authority (State Government) for admissions shall be the same as for regular admissions. The admissions in respect of the T.F.W. Scheme shall be given effect to by the State Government designated Admission Authority (J.E.E. Committee/D.E.T. Committee).
4. The scheme shall be mandatory for all institutions approved by the Council.
5. Sons and daughters of parents whose annual income is less than Rs. 2.50 lakhs from all sources shall only be eligible for seats under this scheme.
6. The waiver is limited to the tuition fee as approved by the State Level Fee Committee for self-financing Institutions and by the Government for the Government and Government Aided Institutions. All other fee except tuition fees will have to be paid by the beneficiary.
7. Admission in respect of the T.F.W. Scheme will be made by the State Government designated Admission Authority, i.e. through J.E.E. Committee/D.E.T. Committee strictly on the basis of J.E.E. merit list/D.E.T. merit list as the case may be.

8. In the event of non-availability of students in this category, the same shall not be given to any other category of applicants.
9. The J.E.E. Committee/D.E.T. Committee shall invite applications under this category, make a separate merit list for this category and effect admissions on the basis of merit list so generated.
10. The institutions shall publish in their brochure and website the details of the T.F.W. Scheme.
11. The J.E.E. Committee/D.E.T. Committee shall submit a separate merit list of the students admitted under this category to the institute to which they are admitted for necessary compliance.
12. A letter in this respect shall be issued by the J.E.E. Committee/D.E.T. Committee for admissions to each beneficiary student admitted under T.F.W. Scheme and he/she shall not be allowed to change Institution/Course under any circumstances.
13. The institutions shall also display information regarding admitted candidates in their websites for information to the students and other stakeholders.

Further, it is prescribed that the above T.F.W. Scheme is applicable for natives of Orissa and the candidates willing to take admission under T.F.W. Scheme shall have to produce the nativity certificate. The candidates seeking admission under T.F.W. Scheme shall have to produce the income certificate issued from the concerned Tahasildar.
