AWARD

The Government of Orissa in exercise of the powers conferred by sub-section (5) of Section 12, read with Clause (c) of sub-section (1) of Section 10 of the Industrial Disputes Act, 1947 have referred the matter in dispute to this Court vide Order No. 7856–li/1-(BH)-20/1996-LE., dated the 8th July 1996 of the Labour & Employment Department, Bhubaneswar for adjudication.

2. The terms of reference is as follows :

“Whether the action of the District Transport Manager (A), O.S.R.T.C., Bhadrak in terminating the services of Shri Jairam Barik, Casual Conductor, with effect from the 16th July 1995 is legal and/or justified ? If not, to what relief Shri Barik is entitled ?”.

3. Both the parties are absent. No steps taken. The workman has remained absent since long. In absence of the parties and evidence in record, the reference cannot be answered. Hence, a no Award is possible passed accordingly.
