### NOTIFICATION

The 24th August, 2011

No. 7752-SS-II-SC-42/2011/LE.— Whereas, the draft notice of 30 days intending to extend the provisions of the Employees State Insurance Act, 1948 (34 of 1948) by the State Government to the classes of establishment as specified in Column (1) within the area mentioned in Column (2) of the Schedule to the notification of the Government of Orissa in the Labour & Employment Department No. 4280-SS-II-SC-42/2011/LE., dated the 5th May, 2011 was published as required by sub-section (5) of Section 1 of the said Act;

And, whereas, compliance to the above provisions of the said Act by issuance of 30 days notice in the State Gazette intending of doing so by the State Government has in the meantime been over;

Now, therefore, in exercise of the powers conferred by sub-section (5) of Section 1 of the said Act and in consultation with the Employees State Insurance Corporation, the State Government with the approval of the Central Government do hereby extend the provisions of the said Act to the classes of establishments specified in column (1) within the areas mentioned in column (2) thereof in the Schedule given below on the date of publication of this notification in the official gazette of the State.

### SCHEDULE

The following establishments whereon ten or more persons are employed, or were employed on any day of the preceding twelve months, namely:—	All areas where the provisions of the ESI Act, 1948 have already been brought into force under sub-section (3) of Section 1 of the Act.

- (i) Shops;
- (ii) Hotels;
- (iii) Restaurants;
- (iv) Road Motor Transport establishments;
- (v) Cinemas including preview theatres;
- (vi) Newspaper establishments as defined in Section 2(d) of the Working Journalists (conditions of service) and Miscellaneous Provisions Act, 1955 (45 of 1955).
- (vii) Educational Institutions (including public, private, aided or partially aided) run by individuals, trustees, societies or other organization; and
- (viii) Medical Institutions (Including Corporate, Joint Sector, Trust, Charitable and Private Ownership Hospitals, Nursing Homes, Diagnostic Centers, Parthological Labs)
