AWARD

The Government of Orissa in the Labour & Employment Department in exercise of Powers conferred upon them by sub-section (5) of Section 12, readwith Clause (d) of sub-section (1) of Section 10 of the Industrial Disputes Act, 1947 (14 of 1947) have referred the following dispute for adjudication vide their Order No. 6813—li(J)-8/2003-LE., dated the 16th July 2003 :—

“Whether the action of the management of M/s the Orissa State Co-op. Marketing Federation Ltd. (MARKFED), Old Station Road, Bhubaneswar by refusing employment of Shri Krushna Chandra Mallia, ex-Typist with effect from the 28th April 2001 is legal and/or justified ? If not, to what relief Shri Mallia is entitled ?”

2. Both parties are absent. No steps taken. On perusal of the case record I found that the workman was absent in the Court since long and not taking interest to proceed with his case. I also found no reasonable ground to adjourn the case further more as sufficient opportunities have been given to the workman. Hence in absence of evidence on record a no award possible is passed accordingly.
