AWARD

This case arises out of the reference made by the Government of Orissa, Labour & Employment Department conferred by sub-section (5) of Section-12, read with Clause (c) of sub-section (1) of Section-10 of the Industrial Disputes Act, 1947 (14 of 1947) vide Memo No. 2686 (5) Dtd. 18-3-2011 for adjudication of the dispute in the schedule :

“Whether the change of status of 258 workmen who were on the direct roll of M/s G. K. W. Ltd., (P. S. Division) presently known as M/s Graphite India Ltd., At Turla, Titilagarh, Dist. Bolangir to that of contractors workmen with effect from Dtd. 20-02-2009 is legal, proper and/or justified ? If not, what relief are the workmen entitled to ?”

The Second party workman neither filed their statement of claim nor took any step in the Court as per Order of the State Government, Labour & Employment Department contained in the reference and also on issue of repeated notices from the Court. As it appears that the workman are not interested to proceed with the present case. Hence, I do hereby pass, ‘No Dispute Award’, so far as the present reference is concerned.
