AWARD

The Government of Orissa in the Labour & Employment Department in exercise of the powers conferred upon them by sub-section (5) of Section 12, read with Clause (d) of sub-section (1) of Section 10 of the Industrial Disputes Act, 1947 (14 of 1947) have referred following dispute for adjudication vide their Order No. 6233-li/1(B)-26/2004-L.E., dated the 17th July 2004 :

"Whether the termination of services of Shri Bhuban Mohan Rath with effect from the 12th May 1997 by the management of M/s. Jagabandhu Enterprisers, Bhubaneswar is legal and/or justified ? If not, what relief Shri Rath is entitled to ?"

2. The workman is absent. No steps taken. On perusal of the case record I found that the workman neither present in the Court nor filed his claim statement till yet which amounts that he was not interested to proceed with his case. I also found no reasonable ground to adjourn the case furthermore as sufficient oppertunities given to him. Hence in absence of claim statement and evidence on record a no Award possible is passed accordingly.
