RESOLUTION

SUBJECT—Constitution of State Level Committee (S.L.C.) under the Integrated Action Plan (I.A.P.) for monitoring of the I.A.P. and other Flagship Programmes in Backward and Tribal Districts of the State.

The Government of Odisha are committed to achieving all round socio-economic development of the State in general and Backward and Tribal Districts in particular by ensuring timely and effective implementation of large number of development programmes/projects/schemes. The Integrated Action Plan (I.A.P.) is being implemented by the State Government in eighteen (18) Backward and Tribal Districts with a view to bringing about quick perceptible improvement and visible impact in public infrastructure and services through implementation of short gestation prioritised tangible projects reflecting the felt critical needs and giving benefits to the local people. It has been considered desirable that I.A.P. and other flagship schemes are carefully monitored from time to time.

**Composition of the State Level Committee :**

2. For smooth and timely implementation of the Integrated Action Plan (I.A.P.) as well as other important flagship programmes in the identified Backward and Tribal Districts, it has been considered expedient to constitute a State Level Committee (S.L.C.) for the purpose. The State Government, therefore, do hereby constitute a State Level Committee with the following composition with a view to review, monitor and recommend appropriate follow up action on I.A.P. and other Flagship Programmes in the identified Backward and Tribal Districts :—

3. The Chairperson shall have the authority to invite any official/authority/organisation to the meeting as per the need. The Planning & Co-ordination Department is designated as the Nodal Department and the Member-Secretary of the Committee as the Nodal Officer who shall act as the Member-Convenor to convene meeting of the Committee as and when required.

**Functions of the State Level Committee :**

4. The main functions of the State Level Committee shall be as follows :—

- (i) To oversee and monitor timely implementation of the I.A.P. and other flagship programmes from time to time in all identified Backward and Tribal Districts of the State.
- (ii) To review progress periodically and address bottlenecks and hurdles, if any, in the implementation process as well as utilisation of facilities and services created under the schemes.
- (iii) To co-ordinate activities of different Departments connected with the implementation of programmes and if necessary, to suggest appropriate actions to the concerned line Departments.
- (iv) To monitor transfer of assets created to the concerned Gram Panchayats/Panchayat Samities/Department as per activity mapping of the State for their proper use, operation and maintenance.
- (v) To commission/outsourcing relevant studies and examine various districts specific issues/concerns that impact backwardness.
- (vi) To undertake such other tasks/activities as may be assigned to it by the State Government from time to time for effective implementation of the programmes.

5. The State Level Committee shall devise its own rules of business and procedures.

6. The Committee shall meet at least once in a quarter or as and when necessary.

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ORDER—It is ordered that the Resolution be published in the Extraordinary Gazette of the Odisha Government for the general information and copy be communicated to all Departments of Government/Heads of Department and others concerned.
