AWARD

The Government of Odisha in the Labour & Employment Department in exercise of powers conferred under sub-section (5) of Section 12, read with Clause (d) of sub-section (1) of Section 10 of the Industrial Disputes Act, 1947 have referred the following dispute vide Order No. 4828—li-1(SS)-61/2002-LE., dated the 16th May 2003 for adjudication :—

“Whether the action of the Management of M/s Puruk Vinimay Ltd., At Alepe Court, 4th Floor, 225C, Acharya Jagadish Ch. Bose Road, Kolkata - 20 in terminating the services of Shri Sanjay Anand, Medical Representative with effect from the 27th February 2002 is legal and/or justified ? If not, what relief Shri Anand is entitled to ?”.

2. On notices being sent both parties remained absent on calls inspite of receiving the notices issued from this Court. So it seems that either there is no dispute or they have settled their dispute amicably outside the Court. Accordingly No Dispute Award is passed.
