AWARD

The Government of Odisha in Labour & Employment Department in exercise of their powers conferred under sub-section (5) of Section 12, read with Clause (d) of sub-section (1) of Section 10 of the Industrial Disputes Act have referred the following dispute vide Order No. 6478—li/1(SS)-21/2006-LE., dated the 19th July 2006 for adjudication :—

"Whether the action of the management of Rourkela Steel Plant by withdrawing the customary benefits of Shri G. D. Dash, PI. No. 38851, Senior Operator (TP & TLK) of Project and Modernisation Department by way of transfer of Shri Dash as Senior Executive Assistant at the fag end of his service career affecting his retiral benefits is legal and/or justified ? If not, to what relief Shri Dash is entitled ?"

2. On notices being sent neither of the parties are present on calls. So it seems that either there is no dispute or they have settled their dispute amicably outside the Court. Accordingly No Dispute Award is passed.
