## AWARD

The Government of Odisha in Labour & Employment Department in exercise of their powers conferred under sub-section (5) of Section 12, read with Clause (d) of sub-section (1) of Section 10 of the Industrial Disputes Act have referred the following dispute vide Order No. 13957—li/1(SS)-42/2006-LE., dated the 24th December 2007 for adjudication :—

"Whether the demand of the Union, i.e., Annual Increment be paid @ 200 per annum is legal and/or justified ? If so, what would be the quantum and details regarding Annual Increment ?"

2. Today both parties are found absent on calls. From this, it can be presumed that either they have settled their dispute outside the Court or they have no interest to conduct the case. Hence, No Dispute Award is passed.
