Annexure I

Terms & Conditions and Selection Criteria for Engagement of Consultants under I.S.S.P.

Introduction :

The attributes of robust Statistical system is to provide timely and reliable data with analysis and interpretations. Since the DE & S collects, compiles and collates huge volumes of data, it is imperative to strengthen the Directorate and Department for better out-puts.

India Statistical Strengthening Project (ISSP) has been implemented in the State for strengthening Statistical system in the DE & S and departments. The ISSP focuses on improvement of following five components :

- (a) Improving the co-ordination and management of statistical activities ;
- (b) Human Resource Development (HRD) ;
- (c) Developing the Statistical Infrastructure ;
- (d) Investing in Physical Infrastructure, Including IT ; and
- (e) Improving statistical operations through dissemination of statistical data.

For improvement of analytical capabilities of the officials of DE & S, DPMUs and Departments, the Directorate has procured SPSS statistical package. Besides above, the Directorate has procured hardware/software and aimed at development of data base and web-based transmission of data, etc.

For smooth implementation and to achieve the desired out-put, it is proposed to engage one Consultant for training & Capacity building and two Junior Consultants for IT (H/W and S/W support) under ISSP as follows :

- To prepare reports and disseminate results
- To improve proficiency in computer application (software/hardware)
- Evaluate performance of the officials

- Improving analytical capabilities of officials of DE & S and DPMUs using SPSS package
- preparation of reports and participate in dissemination programmes
- Evaluate performance of the officials.

Junior Consultants (IT–s/w and h/w)

- Provide technical support on ITs & develop application software for the DE & S
- Maintain data base of DE & S and DPMUs
- Impart training on computer application to officials of DE & S
- Advice on procurement, installation & maintenance of software
- Maintain LAN infrastructure of DE & S
- Advice on procurement, installation & maintenance of hardware
- Provide distance learning through video conferencing
- Evaluate performance of the divisions

Schedule for Completion of tasks :

- The Consultant, SPSS (Training & Capacity building) and two Junior Consultants (IT-Software/Hardware) will be engaged for a period of 03 years from 2014-15 to 2016-17 to take-up the tasks as above subject to satisfactory performance. Their performances will be evaluated every year by the Competent Authority.

The support or inputs/materials/data to be provided by the Competent Authority :

- The Consultant (Training & Capacity building) will be supplied with SPSS package and data of censuses & surveys conducted by DE & S. He shall organize training on data analysis & presentation to the statistical officials in consultation with the Principal, RIPAE & S.
- The Junior Consultants shall be engaged for providing IT support to the officials of DE & S. They will be attached to the Computer Centre under Deputy Director (Computer Centre) of DE & S.

Final Out puts in comprehensive terms that will be required of the Consultant/Jr. Consultants :

- All statistical officers and staff of DE & S, DPMUs & Departments shall be trained on SPSS properly & should be able to analyze & present data effectively.
- All statistical officials shall acquire knowledge on IT applications both in terms of s/w & h/w

The detail essential qualification, experience, age limits, expected roles & responsibilities, remunerations & duration of services of the Consultants/Jr. Consultants required have been detailed in the statement enclosed.

Cost Involvement :

Under ISSP, the appointment of Consultants/Jr. Consultants shall be for a period of 3 years subject to satisfactory performances, to be evaluated every year.
