## AWARD

The Government of Odisha in Labour & Employment Department in exercise of their powers conferred under sub-section (5) of Section 12 read with Clause (d) sub-section (1) of Section 10 of the Industrial Disputes Act have referred the following dispute vide Order No. 9596—li/1(SS)-16/2007, dated the 13th August 2007 for adjudication :—

“Whether the demand of the IDL Chemicals Workers Union, Binaya Bhawan, Sonaparbat, Rourkela - 16 for payment of *ex gratia* at higher rate for the accounting year 2004-05 by the management of M/s Gulf Oil Corporation Ltd. (IDL Division), Sonaparbat, Rourkela is justified ? If so, what should be the details ?”.

2. The case is fixed today for appearances of the parties, but today neither of the parties appeared before this Tribunal nor sent any information. Hence, it can be presumed that at present there is no dispute between them or they have settled the dispute outside the court in the mean time. Accordingly no dispute award is passed.
