NOTIFICATION

The 25th April, 2015

S.R.O. No.154/2015. Whereas, under the provisions of sub-section (3) of section 89 of the Bihar and Odisha Excise Act, 1915 (Bihar and Odisha Act II of 1915) the powers to make rules are subject to the condition that the rules be made after previous publication;

And, whereas, under the proviso to the said provision such rules may be made without previous publication, if the State Government considers that they should be brought into force at once;

And, whereas, the State Government considers that the following rules should be brought into force at once;

Now, therefore, in exercise of the powers conferred by sub-section (1) read with the proviso to sub-section (3) of Section 89 of the Bihar and Odisha Excise Act, 1915 (Bihar and Odisha Act II of 1915), the State Government do hereby make the following rules further to amend the Odisha Excise (Exclusive Privilege) Rules, 1970, namely: -

1. Short title and commencement. - (1) These rules may be called the Odisha Excise (Exclusive Privilege) Amendment Rules, 2015.

(2) They shall come into force on the date of their publication in the Official Gazette.

2. In rule 4 of the Odisha Excise (Exclusive Privilege) Rules, 1970, (hereinafter referred to as the said rules), for the words ~~the Collector shall proceed~~, the words and comma ~~the Collector or a Committee as may be constituted by the State Government,~~ shall proceed+shall be substituted.

3. In the said rules, after rule-6D; the following rule shall be inserted, namely: -

~~6-E~~ power to specify modality, etc. - Notwithstanding anything contained in these rules, the State Government may specify modality, eligibility criteria and determine any condition including consideration amount or fee and such other matters for grant of exclusive privilege under these rules.+
