2. The above Project Level Steering Committee (PLSC) shall act as the Single-Window mechanism at the project level to resolve key issues on implementation of the Energy Efficient Public Street Lighting Project in Rourkela Municipal Corporation (CMC) under PPP mode.

3. The PLSC shall meet periodically involving the Transaction Advisor to review/ monitor the progress of implementation of the said project and take appropriate steps to get rid of the bottlenecks, if any on the way of its implementation.

4. The PLSC shall report the progress of the project from time to time to the Government and seek intervention of the Government, wherever necessary to resolve the issues, if any.

5. The PLSC shall come in to existence from the date of issue of the notification.
