Makar Sankranti–15th January, Netaji Subash Chandra Bose Jayanti/Veer Surendra Sai Jayanti–23rd January, Republic Day–26th January, Basanta Panchami–14th February, Panchayati Raj Divas–5th March, Maha Shivaratri–8th March, Dola Purnima–25th March, Holi–26th March, Good Friday–29th March, Utkal Divas–1st April, Id-Ul-Fitre–11th April, Shreeram Navami–17th April, Buddha Purnima/Birthday of Pandit Raghunath Murmu–23rd May, Sabitri Amabasya–6th June, Pahili Raja–14th June, Raja Sankranti–15th June, Id-Uz-Zuha–17th June, Moharrum–17th July, Independence Day–15th August, Jhulana Purnima–19th August, Janmastami–26th August, Ganesh Puja–7th September, Birthday of Prophet Mohammed–16th September, Gandhi Jayanti/ Mahalaya–2nd October, Maha Saptami–10th October, Maha Astami–11th October, Kumar Purnima–16th October, Kali Puja/Diwali–31st October, Rasa Purnima–15th November, Xmas Day–25th December.

As Maha Visuba Sankranti/Dr. B.R. Ambedkar Jayanti–14th April, Ratha Yatra–7th July, Nuakhai–8th September, Maha Navami–12th October, Vijaya Dashami– 13th October fall on Sundays and Second Saturday of the months, these festivals have not been declared as holidays.
